TOWN OF LODI TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES DECEMBER 30, 2019

1. Call to order, roll call & Pledge of Allegiance: Meeting called to order by Chairman Henry @ 6:00 p.m. Board members present: Brian Henry, James Brooks, Aaron Arnold, Chad Wolter. Absent: Jon Plumer. Also present: Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Jay Gawlikoski and Public Works Director Roger Henn.

2. Citizen Input: Allison Seaton – could we have dialogue with the board when you get to the Park Commission report (agenda item #9(c)(ii))? We had 35 people here at the last Park Commission meeting. After residents left that meeting the commission discussed several subjects relating to the Bay Drive park that were not what the residents had expressed they wanted done with that park. Henry – due to roads getting icy, *I motion to move that dialogue up to right after this Citizen input, seconded by James Brooks; MC 4-0.**

Martha Dodge Alberti – what has happened relating to the high capacity well (Zeman property)? Henry – we're still work on estimates and will report at the January meeting.

Mary Ann Johnson – I would like some type of florescent paint on the uneven sidewalk outside of this meeting room.

Jim Wartinbee – what about the dead tree(s) on the Cleary property at the corner of Bay Drive? Henry – we just received estimates on removing those and will be reviewing them.

9(c)(ii). Park Commission: Roberta Arnold – maybe Brooks could give a report of what was discussed at the last Park Commission meeting on 12/12/2019. Brooks - we talked about Bay Drive park and whether it should be sold. Our advisory vote to the board was NOT to sell that property. Then we discussed projects, etc... to be done out of the Parks 2020 Budget. We talked about removing the dead trees in the Bay Drive park, and to put in a gravel parking space for 2 vehicles along the road at the entrance to the park. Allison Seaton – do we know for sure that it's not going to be sold? Henry – it's not an agenda item tonight. Brooks – it is not on tonight's agenda, and the current Town Board is not going to vote on it because the recommendation by the Park Commission was to not sell it. Allison Seaton – none of the residents who spoke at the last Park Commission meeting expressed wanting a parking area at that park. Brooks – the 2020 Budget was on the agenda that evening, and the residents could have stayed to listen when we talked about that; what might be done at the Bay Drive park was included in the 2020 Budget discussion. Henry – I think there should be a lot of input and discussion of what to do to that park. Allison Seaton – I heard that there was a comment made to clear cut the shoreline, in violation of law? Brooks – that comment was made, and we firmly stated that clear cutting WOULD NOT happen. Roberta Arnold - the fact that you improve a park doesn't make it unable to be sold; I also saw 2 trees have been taken down. Brooks – THAT was not done by the Town of Lodi. Collins – then we need to find out who took them down, as they were perfectly good trees. Henry – did you report that to the town? Collins – no. Jim Seaton – it might be a good idea to notify the people on Bay Drive that there IS going to be a park at that location, but that any changes to the park will be fully discussed at a Park Commission meeting, and only work authorized by the Town will be allowed. Brooks – the next scheduled meeting will be March 18, 2020. James Wartinbee – the neighbor to the park did have tree(s) removed on their property and they are lying near the road. Also, different parks can serve

different purposes. Some can have playground equipment, some have benches for quite activities, some have walking paths. Wolter – have a designated flat place to park is better than just parking along the road. Teri Jozwiak – I was at the last Park Commission meeting and it was brought up that there was a plan about 5 years ago relating to that park. Allison Seaton – when Madeline Summers dedicated that park land, she meant it to be a dedicated park for locals. Roberta Arnold – the town should do an assessment of the quality of the trees in that park. James Wartinbee – you'd be using the DNR in any plans for that park? Henry – yes. Alberti – this park was designated as an access spot for the public, and there are many more in the town. Allison Seaton – when it comes to signs for the parks remember we are a prairie, not the north woods. The sign out front of the town hall is totally incorrect for this area. Martha Dodge Alberti – where the Okee Conservation Park path comes out to Demynck, all along that area there needs to be signage for "no dumping", seems people dump leaves, grass clippings in there and it's killed the beautiful pond that once was there. Abby Clepper – I think everyone is on the same page here. Before we start making improvements there should be a plan that everyone can see and comment on.
