



MAP 5-10 WOODLANDS & MANAGED FOREST LAW Town of Lodi Columbia County, Wisconsin



1. Forested areas extracted from WDNR's landcover dataset. Landcover data set is a raster representation of vegetation/land cover for the State.




MAP 5-11 OPEN SPACES & OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL RESOURCES



It includes only those sites that have been reported to the Wisconsin Historical Society. It is estimated that less than one percent of the archaeological sites in the state have been identified.


2. The National Register of Historic Places recognizes properties of local, state, and national significance. The Wisconsin State Register of Historic Places also recognizes significant historic sites. Properties are listed in the National and State Register because of their associations with significant historic events, persons, architecture or engineering.


