APPLIANCES

- Freezer - \$20 each
- Refrigerator (any size) - \$20 each
- Air Conditioner - \$20 each
- Dehumidifier - \$20 each
- Microwave - \$5
- Range/Stove - \$5 each
- Gas Grill - \$5 each
- Washer/Dryer - \$5 each

FURNITURE – ONLY ACCEPTED THE 1ST AND 3RD SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH

- Sofa, couch or love seat - \$20 each
- Sectional sofa - \$25 minimum
- Recliner, arm or accent chair - \$15 each
- Kitchen/Dining table - \$15
- Kitchen/dining chairs, bar stools, office chairs - \$5 each
- Dresser, vanity, chest of drawers, entertainment center - \$10 each
- Mattress, box spring or mattress topper - \$10

PLUMBING

- Sinks, toilet or urinals - \$5 each
- Bathtub - \$10 each
- Shower stall or tub surround - \$15
- Water heater - \$5
- Water softener - \$5

ELECTRONICS

- Television 32" or larger - \$25 each
- Television 32" or smaller - \$15 each
- Desktop CPU - \$5 each
- Monitor - \$5 each
- Laptop - \$5 each
- Printer - \$5 each
- Copier - \$5
- Business copier/printer - \$40 each
- Small electronics - \$2 each (DVD player, stereo, scanner, fax machine, ect.)

FLOORING MATERIAL

- Carpet – \$5 per 500 sqft

HOURS: Saturday 8:00am – 4:00pm

Wednesday 3:00pm – 7:00pm

- Padding - \$2 per 500 sqft
- Vinyl flooring - \$5 per 500 sqft
- Plank flooring (Pergo type) - \$5 per 500 sqft
- Area and accent rugs – \$5/\$10 each
- Tile flooring varies by quantity – Min \$10

LARGE ITEMS AND NON-COMPACTABLE REFUSE

- Call ahead to approve/schedule any larger projects.
- See attendant prior to unloading for estimate of dumping fee's – Minimum \$5 to a Maximum \$40

MISCELLANEOUS RECYCLABLE ITEMS

- Used Oil Filters \$5
- Florescent light bulbs \$10

NO FEES FOR THE FOLLOWING RECYCLABLE ITEMS

- Vehicle batteries (all types)
- Rechargeable batteries
- Used engine oil
- Cooking oil

THESE ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTED

- **COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL REFUSE**
- Hot tubs or hot tub covers
- Pallets
- Asphalt roofing materials (shingles and tar paper)
- Medical waste
- Explosives
- Paint – unless dried out in cans
- Solvents
- Thinners
- Pesticides
- Automobiles or motorcycles
- Tires
- Blacktop sealers
- Campers (all types)
- Canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, paddle boats, personal watercraft or boats.
- Logs, firewood and root balls
