

**RESOLUTION 2022-01
REGARDING ELECTION INSPECTORS**

The Town Board of the Town of Lodi, Columbia County, Wisconsin, by this resolution adopted by a majority of the Town Board, on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting, and proper notice having been given, resolves, finds and orders as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 3.11 of the Ordinance of the Town of Lodi provides that each polling place shall have shifts of five or seven election inspectors at all times, excluding any assigned to assist with the election process or act as a greeter; and


WHEREAS, at times there has been difficulty finding sufficient volunteers to act as election inspectors; and

WHEREAS, Section 7.32, Wis. Stats. Provides that a municipality may by resolution reduce the number of election inspectors to no less than three.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Lodi, in legal session assembled that for such elections where the Clerk determines that they are unable to provide full shifts of either five or seven, excluding assistants, that the Clerk may staff any election shift with three election inspectors.

This resolution was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Town of Lodi Board on the 8 day of February 2022.
