Dear Sir or Madam,

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is in the process of pre-plan data gathering for a proposed project on WIS 113 beginning 200-feet north of the WIS 113 / WIS 60 Intersection and stretching northwest 6.2 miles to the WIS 113 / WIS 188 intersection at the Merrimac Ferry Landing. The project will consist of removing 3 1/2 – inches of existing surface and paving back 3 1/2 – inches of new asphaltic material.

Additional work includes installing a safety edge on the new pavement, placement of new shoulder aggregate material, replacement of old or damaged culvert pipes, improvement of curb ramps in the Town of Lodi to be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), installation of centerline rumble strips, replacement of beam guard end terminals to meet new standards, and new pavement marking installation.

The design process will likely take three years (Construction Year 2023), which gives the public time to provide project input. In preparation for the project's design, studies will be conducted to identify environmental and cultural resources located in the project area. To facilitate this process, WisDOT requests that property owners share information they may have pertaining to archaeological resources, historical structures, erosion control/wetland locations, endangered species, and hazardous/contaminated materials that may be located in the project area. Additional studies may include soil testing and survey work. Information obtained will help WisDOT avoid or minimize the proposed project's effect on these resources' while providing a safe and cost-efficient roadway for the community.

State Statute 84.01(10) gives WisDOT and their representatives the right to access your property to gather the aforementioned data. In addition to this, we would like to gather any current property owner's information, addresses, and any questions or concerns you may have regarding our project. **Please reply within 30 days to ensure your feedback is received in the early stages of the design process.** My contact info is listed below. Lastly, I would like to thank you in advance for your assistance and cooperation in our design process.
