

RESOLUTION 2021-01

**ADOPTING WARD PLAN AND ALDERMANIC DISTRICTS, AND COMBINING
MUNICIPAL WARDS FOR VOTING PURPOSES**

WHEREAS Wis. Stats. §5.15 requires all cities, villages and towns with the population of 1,000 or more to establish municipal wards based on the results of the 2021 census: and

WHEREAS Wis. Stats. § 59.10(3)(b) requires that each County Board adopt and transmit to each municipal governing body in the County a tentative County Supervisory District Plan, dividing the County into Districts and designating the approximate location and population of each ward proposed to effectuate the division of the County into Districts; and

WHEREAS, these laws require that each municipality designate by consecutive whole number, geographical description and population, the various wards to be created within the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Lodi adopts the wards described as follows:

WARD 1, which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 25, Population 899

WARD 2, which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 25, Population 595

WARD 3, which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 25, Population 650

WARD 4, which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 26, Population 422

WARD 5, which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 26, Population 716

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above ward boundaries are outlined and identified on the attached map (Attachment A), which is incorporated and made a part hereof, and that the map is generated using WISE-LR software in order to incorporate the underlying census block numbers within each ward;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Wards 1 through 5 created above are hereby combined for voting purposes, so as to share a common polling place, which will be Town of Lodi, W10919 County Rd V., Lodi, WI 53555, and such combined wards shall use common ballot boxes and ballots or voting machines and separate returns shall not be maintained for the combined wards at any election, except where separate ballots are required under Wis. Stats. §§5.58 to 5.64, and separate ballots or voting machines shall be maintained for any electors of one or more of the combined wards who are ineligible to vote for any office or referendum for which other electors in the combined wards may vote.;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon passage a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the City Clerk, who shall transmit a copy of the ward plan and this resolution to the County Clerk and the Legislative Reference Bureau within five (5) days of its adoption and that this resolution shall remain in effect for each election until modified or rescinded, in accordance with Statute, or until a new division is made following the next federal decennial census.


This resolution was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Town of Lodi Board on the 12th day of October 2021.



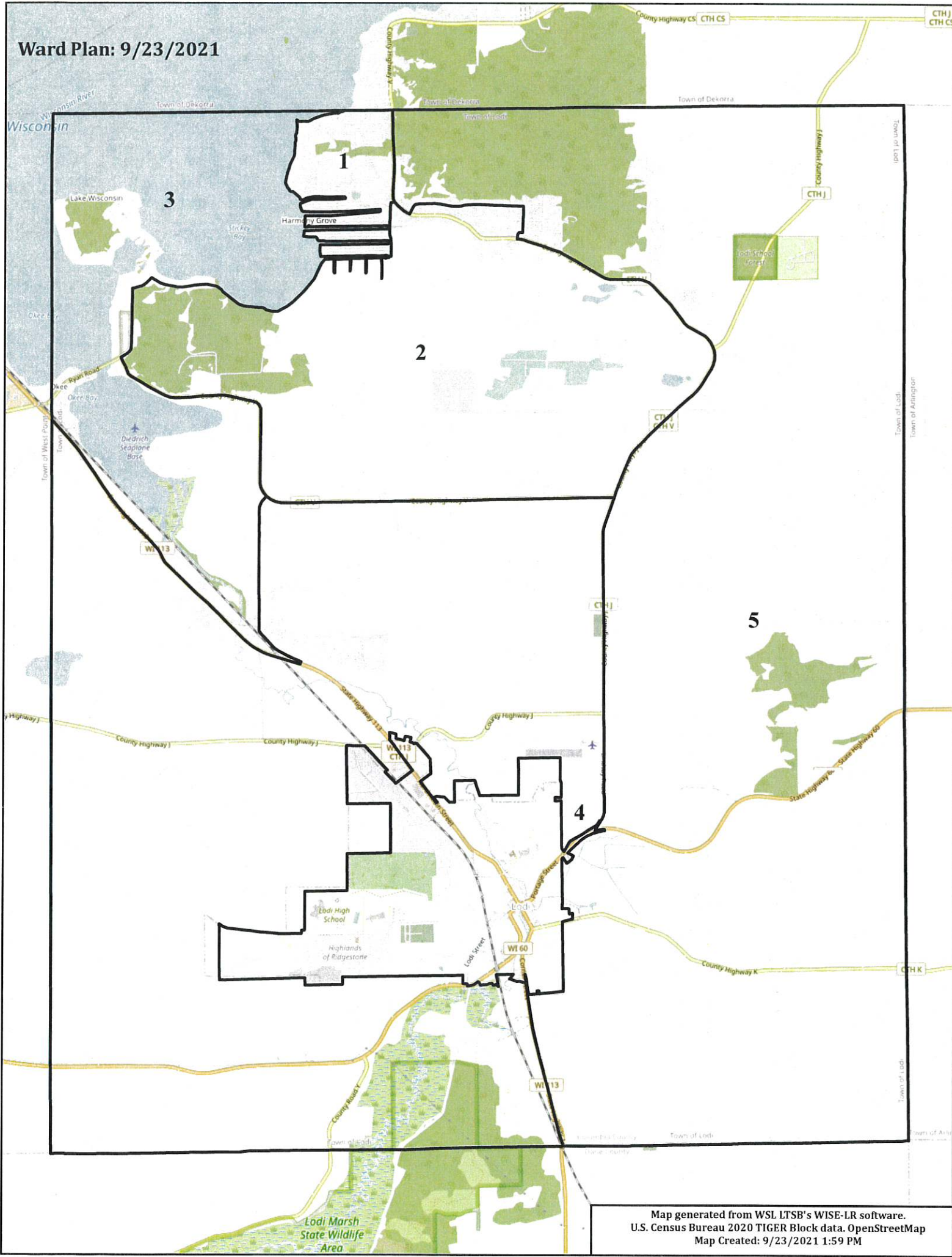
