## SECTION 9.01 PARK REGULATIONS

- (a) The Town parks shall be open to the public from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. except when different hours are authorized by the Town Board.
- (b) The following park rules shall be observed in all parks owned or controlled by the Town:
  - (1) No horses or unleashed pets allowed in the parks.
  - (2) No bicycles, motorcycles or minibikes to be driven in the park.
  - (3) No motor vehicles shall be operated in the parks.
  - (4) Snowmobiles shall not be operated in parks. "Snowmobile" means any engine driven vehicle as defined in Wis. Stats. Chap. 350.
  - (5) No fires except in places provided in parks.
  - (6) No loud music or noise that disturbs the peace.
  - (7) No drunk or disorderly conduct.
  - (8) No intoxicating liquor shall be consumed in the parks. No fermented malt beverages shall be consumed in the parks unless approved by the Town Board. Persons or groups wishing to sponsor events at which fermented malt beverages will be served shall apply to the Town to obtain either:
    - (A) A Temporary Class "B" Picnic license to sell fermented malt beverages at picnics or gatherings; or
    - (B) A special permit to serve but not sell fermented malt beverages at the picnic or gathering.
  - (9) No Class "B" or "C" fireworks are allowed in the parks.
  - (10) No tables or benches are to be removed from the parks or moved from one park to another.
  - (11) No littering or destruction of property.
  - (12) No one shall obstruct passage in any way on any trail in any park of the Town, park vehicles on any Town trail, leave litter on any Town trail, damage any Town trail, or in any way disturb the public's enjoyment of any Town trail.
  - (13) No person shall hunt or trap any animal or discharge any firearm, bow, crossbow, or any other dangerous weapon in any Town park. The prohibition on discharging a weapon shall not apply to the discharge of any weapon under circumstances described under Wis. Stats. § 939.45.

(c) All violations of this Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture in accordance with Section 1.21 of this Code.
